The Liaison Team is a multidisciplinary team comprised of Health Promoters, Registered Dietitian, Public Health Nurse, Public Health Inspector, and Managers. Our role is to support key stakeholder groups including long-term care and retirement homes, agencies supporting older adults, primary care, municipalities, workplaces and business owners, schools and daycares, shelters and other congregate settings. We synthesize and share key information and provide guidance on infection protection and control with the goal of protecting the most vulnerable people in our community.
