# Re: Sale and Distribution of Unpasteurized Milk

The Ontario Public Health Association (OPHA) would like to join our partners in public health in commending you on your stance to uphold existing requirements for mandatory pasteurization of milk and milk products in Ontario.

We are referring specifically to your recent comments in the media and the news release dated November 29 highlighting the great health risks associated with the consumption of unpasteurized milk. As you are aware, much scientific evidence exists of outbreaks of human illness related to the consumption of unpasteurized/raw milk in both Canada and the United States. Although anyone can be affected, those most vulnerable to serious illness are our children, our senior citizens, and those with weakened immune systems. Pasteurization markedly increases the safety of milk and milk products, and reduces the risk of significant food-borne illness for all Ontarians.

OPHA's members work in all fields of public health, including food safety and the prevention of infectious disease outbreaks. We look forward to working with you and supporting your efforts to maintain and strengthen a public health system that protects the health and safety of all Ontario residents.
