Reporting to the Manager, Child and Family Health, is responsible for leading statistical data projects, informing research projects and supporting Public Health to fulfill the Ontario Public Health Standards requirements; ensuring appropriate use of data analysis methods for program evaluation and adequately assessing reliability and validity of data to provide services that are evidence informed, influence health outcomes; leading projects, including technology related projects, to improve the ability to provide timely and accurate data; providing advice and conducting analysis and application of statistical data to the branch programs and services, including establishing consistent processes for compiling, tracking and verifying program data, analyzing demographic, economic and statistical data; leading the development of branch performance measures; writing reports and designing and developing complex spreadsheets and database applications.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

- Develops frameworks and dashboards integrating KPIs at all levels for various programs within the division.
- Develops and implements systematic, proactive continuous collection, analysis and interpretation of indicators.
- Provides statistical data analysis and support to the division including extracting, importing and exporting data in various data applications.
- Project manages from initiation to closing including development and implementation of project charters, work plans and responsibility matrices, including a variety of projects such system re-design, process improvement projects, technology improvements related to client service delivery.
- Provides expertise related to data collection.
- Analyzes and estimates project costs; presents cost options to clients and provides options for outsourcing the

appropriate resources needed.

- Provides advice to quantitative data analysis methodologies to support research projects
- Advises internal programs on effective data analysis practices as well as technology development / implementation.
- Identifies and uses tools, structures and processes to measure and improve quality of programs and services.
- Leads documentation and system audits; identify variances in individual practices from standards.
- Responds to inquiries and resolves concerns, as appropriate.
- Ensures that services provided meet Regional customer service standards.
- Performs other duties as assigned, in accordance with Branch and Department objectives.
